# Proposed Revisions to the GSLDTC Constitution and By Laws

Each November when the newly elected Board Members take office, we go through our Constitution and By Laws to see if any changes should be made. This year we found some items that needed revising. They are listed below and I have also attached a pdf of the proposed changes within the Constitution and By Laws document for you to review.

Great Salt Lake Dog Training Club

Suggested Changes to By Laws and Constitution

#### **Changes to Constitution**

Section 2 (e) ..... tracking tests, other AKC adopted performance events

#### Changes to By Laws

#### **Article III**

**Section 1** The officers shall be elected for a term of two years or until their

successors take office

ELIMINATE: may be re-elected for one additional year, may not serve

more than two terms consecutively in the same office, with the exception of the Executive Secretary may be re-elected.

#### Article IV

Section 2 CHANGE: in accordance with Section 4 of this Article. To read

Section 3

#### Article V add the following

#### Section 4 General Duties of Committee Chairman

The Committee Chairperson are not members of the Club Board

They attend Board meetings as directed by the President

Committee Chairpersons are not elected

They serve at the pleasure of the President as approved by

the Board

#### **Duties of the Advertising Committee Chairperson**

Coordinate all activities intended to promote the Club

Create and maintain a website to promote the Club

Create and maintain a Facebook page for the Club

Create and distribute a monthly news letter

Report any needs or concerns to the Home Secretary

#### **Duties of Performance Committee Chairpersons:**

- Act as the Chairperson (or obtain a chairperson) for all Club sponsored events for their performance area
- Be familiar with and understand all AKC Rules and Regulations related to their performance area
- Be familiar with and update the Club Board on any and all changes made by AKC to the Rules and Regulations for their performance area
- Make sure that all equipment used in events, by the Club, in their performance area complies with AKC Rules and Regulations
- At least thirty (30) days prior to any Club sponsored event, make sure that all equipment to be used in their performance area at the event is in good condition
  - 1. This will include but not limited to
- 1. signs
- 2. stop watches or timers
- 3. jumps
- 4. paperwork
- 5. ring gates
- 6. tape measures
- 7. any other specific equipment necessary to that event
- 2. Report to the show CO Chairpersons the need for any equipment purchases or repairs

Make sure there are sufficient stewards to help with all Club sponsored events in their performance area



**Guideline 4:** Review the minimum charge (\$100.00) per day (Agility)

Review the charge (\$100.00) per day (Obedience, Rally, Tracking)


