





The study plans to review although is not limted to the following scenarios

- 1. Maintain the Equestr an Park and its service operat on as-is.
- 2 Reduce the service offerings at the Equestran Park.
- 3. Increase the service offerings at the Equestrian Park.
- 4 Convert the land into a regional park. This review considers re-purposing much of the Park from an equestrian use to one of field sports use.

The GSLDTC Board and several members attended this meeting. We were just a few of the dog related folks, the majority in attendance were the horse community. It was a strong turn out.




