### Dog Treat Recipe - Zucchini Bread

2 cups Pureed zucchini  
 2 cups oat flour  
 2 tsp baking powder  
 1/2 tsp baking soda  
 1 tsp cinnamon  
 3 eggs

1 tsp vanilla  
 3/4 cup honey  
 1/4 cup safflower oil  
 1/2 cup finely chopped peanuts (optional)

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Cook, slice and puree zucchini in a food processor.

Combine all ingredients together and mix thoroughly. Lightly grease a mini loaf pan (or use a regular muffin pan with cupcake papers placed in it) Spoon mixture evenly into the pan close to the top (the mix will not rise very much)

Bake 20-25 minutes (with either pan). Bread is done when a toothpick inserted in to the center comes out clean. Remove from oven and let cool completely on a wire rack. Store in airtight container in the refrigerator.

Zucchini is one of several squashes that were a mainstay of Native American diets for centuries. These large, green vegetables are loaded with folate and potassium. Their rinds are rich in beta-carotene and should always be included in any recipe featuring this versatile squash.

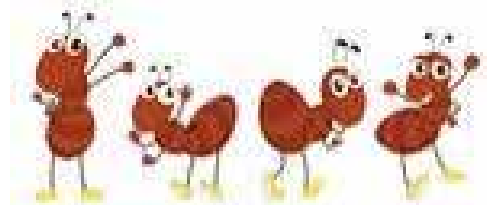

## Dog Treat Recipe - Frosty Paws

1—32 oz plain yogurt or goat yogurt

2 tbsp. peanut butter (be sure it doesn't contain xylitol)

1 ripe banana mashed

2 tbsp. honey

Mix all ingredients together in a mixer.

Pour into ice cube trays. Once frozen you can remove from trays and place in ziplock freezer bags in the freezer.

You can also use small bathroom dixie cups and fill 1/4 full. Once frozen, remove from cups and place in freezer ziplocks bags.
