



When: Aug 27th—6 pm


Where: Murray Park Pavilion #4—440 Vine St.

Dog Treat Recipe - Zucchini Bread

2 cups Pureed zucchini

2 cups oat flour

2 tsp baking powder

1/2 tsp baking soda

1 tsp cinnamon

3 eggs

1 tsp vanilla 3/4 cup honey

1/4 cup safflower oil

1/2 cup finely chopped peanuts (optional)

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Cook, slice and puree zucchini in a food processor.

Combine all ingredients together and mix thoroughly. Lightly grease a mini laf pan (or use a regular muffin pan with cupcake papers placed in it) Spoon mixture evenly into the pan close to the top (the mix will not rise very much)

Bake 20-25 minutes (with either pan). Bread is done when a toothpick inserted in to the center comes out clean. Remove from oven and let cool completely on a wire rack. Store in airtight container in the refrigerator.

Zucchini is one of several squashes that were a mainstay of Native American diets for centuries. These large, green vegetables are loaded with folate and potassium. Their rinds are rich in beta-carotene and should always be included in any recipe featuring this versatile squash.



Obedience & Rally Trials






Anyone earning a New Title at our shows can pick up a New Title Pin.
