

Please contact Show Secretary for information about online entries. There will be an additional service charge for electronic entries. No entry will be deemed complete until all information and payment has been confirmed.

PLEASE NOTE: Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing. An administrative fee of \$3.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

COVID-19 SHOW EVENT POLICIES

You will be required to sign a Health Waiver. It will either be in your Confirmation packet that will be USPS-mailed to you approximately a week prior to the show or it will be emailed to you separately. Bring this signed form with you to the show. It will be collected at your first run and marked as complete in the Stewards' Catalogs. You will not be allowed to show without a signed copy of this form. If you will be in both Rally and Obedience, you might wish to bring a duplicate. Also, if you are in multiple classes, make sure you inform the Steward so that they can mark all of your entries as having completed a Waiver Form. If you disagree with this requirement, you can request a refund up to the date the show closes.

As per COVID-19 guidelines and the Club's safety measures, there will be no crating inside the buildings. Only the current and 'next' Exhibitor will be allowed in the building. Facemasks are required at all times, except while the Exhibitor is in the ring. There will be no spectators allowed and there will be no Awards Ceremonies. All ribbons will be posted in or near the buildings and the scoresheets will be posted at that time if you wish to take a picture of your exercise breakdowns.

ALL OF US TOGETHER

The policies below were developed for the well-being of all of us and with current guidance from <u>AKC's Suggested</u> <u>Best Practices For The Well-Being of Dog Sport Participants</u>, the CDC, and the state of Utah as of May 2020. Because the incidence of COVID-19 can change rapidly, we may adjust our policies. Please review the club's policies that will be displayed at each ring.

FACE MASK/COVERINGS

All club members, volunteers, judges, exhibitors, and spectators will wear face masks/coverings during show hours while on show grounds whenever social distancing of six feet cannot be maintained. Our venue's elevation is, approximately, 4200 feet. If you have any questions or concerns about underlying health issues and this policy, please consult a physician.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE SHOWS

If you or a household member have any of the following symptoms, or if you have recently been exposed to Covid 19, or if you develop any of the following symptoms during the show weekend, do not attend the show(s) and follow CDC, your state, and Utah state guidelines. Following are COVID-19 symptoms: 1) fever, 2) cough, 3) new or increased shortness of breath, 4) decreased sense of smell or taste, 5) sore or scratchy throat, or 6) muscle aches and pains.

If you later test COVID-19 positive, or have a suspected case, contact your state health officials and Utah State health officials at coronavirus.utah.gov, and provide them with relevant show chair(s) contact information.



ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am each trial day. Dogs must be removed DAILY from the show site immediately following completion of the last scheduled class. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted at the fairgrounds. Handlers—Please clean up after your dogs and your area as required.

Exhibitors must keep dogs under control and restrained at all times. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Utah State Law requires all dogs over four (4) months of age be current on rabies vaccination.

Exhibitors MUST be governed by any rules and regulations of the Davis County Fairgrounds and/or local restriction. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except with being judged. Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Show Committee.

NO Double handling will be permitted at these trials, and attempts to do so from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Trial Committee.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the show.

Chapter 2, Section 26, Obedience Regulations— "There will be no intensive nor abusive training of dogs on the grounds or premises at a AKC licensed or member obedience trial or sanctioned match." This rule will be strictly enforced; violators will be subject to a Trial Committee hearing. Special training devices that are used to control and train dogs, including but not limited to, collars with prongs, electric collars used with transmitters, muzzles, and head collars may not be used on dogs at AKC Events, except as allowed in the AKC Rules, Regulations, and policies.

The judging procedure may be modified to accommodate special-needs handlers.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

The show-giving Club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without correct fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing. An administrative fee of \$3.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Entries will be acknowledged no later than after entries close with an entry acknowledgement. Judging Program will be emailed to Exhibitor's email address after show closes and schedule is determined. It is imperative you review the acknowledgement for accuracy and/or missing data. If you wish your Agent to receive an acknowledgement of your entry and/or judging schedule, please submit request with entry, show name and Agent's correct email address for this courtesy. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary by phone at (801)898-9759 or email at DogShowSec@gmail.com.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, and their property, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of any accident or misfortune due to entering dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at each Trial and will not be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Trials. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Trials Premium List.

OBEDIENCE ENTRY FEES <u>include</u> 50 cents AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC event service fee. **RALLY ENTRY FEES** <u>include</u> \$3.50 AKC first entry recording fee and \$3.00 second entry recording fee.

These AKC fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These are not in addition to your entry fee; they are included in your entry fee where applicable.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

No flash photography is allowed, except by Show Photographer as needed.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. In the event of a Returned check, a replacement check will not be acceptable and guaranteed funds will be required. Guaranteed funds are defined as Money Order, Cashier's Check, PayPal Transfer, or Cash. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, except as noted above.

Entry Fees will not be refunded after the closing date and time. Anyone wishing to pull entries must do so in writing prior to the closing date and time. There will be a small fee for this convenience.
