

Hearing More Fireworks Than Usual?

Firework displays are happening frequently across the country and these summertime pyrotechnics can be seriously distressing for pets.

1 in 5 pets goes missing after being scared by loud noises, so make sure your furry friends are safe and comfortable with these tips from our experts.



Never allow your pets near fireworks as they can easily become injured



Keep pets inside and secure while fireworks are going off so they can't ' run away

Make sure your pet has an ID tag and microchip with up-to-date information



Keep a current photo of your pet handy in case they do get lost





Consult your vet for medication if your pet gets particularly frightened by fireworks and loud noises



If you are going out, consider boarding your pet or taking extra steps to keep them secure

COOKING Watermelon Frozen Dog Treats

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups fresh seedless watermelon pieces
- 2/3 cup plain Greek yogurt.
- 2 teaspoons honey

Instructions

- Place silicone molds on a baking sheet (this helps transfer them easily to the freezer without spilling.) Set it aside.
- Put all the ingredients in the bowl of a food processor, blend until combined and smooth.
- Transfer to a measuring cup with a spout, for easy pouring.
- Fill each slot to the top with the mixture.
- Place in the freezer for about 3 hours or until solid.

Fido In Wonderland 5 Great Ideas for A Dog Friendly Yard

Come with me on a journey to make our yards be a Wonderland escape for our furry friends. Having a yard and safe place for our dogs to exercise and play with the family is a must. Here are some ideas to get the most out of their outside time.

- 1. When looking to build our landscape we need to take our dogs safety seriously. There are many landscaping tools that are hazardous to their health.
 - Fertilizer that contains nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium can cause stomach irritation; and should be avoided when using in a pet friendly environment. Just walking on the fertilizer, they can accidentally consume these chemicals by grooming themselves. This can cause long-lasting stomach issues.
 - Cocoa Mulch is a common ground cover that is used to retain water and suspend weed growth. To our pups the mulch has the same scent to dogs as chocolate with the same risk if ingested.
 - Beautiful flowers and plants can be dangerous. Here is a limited list of just some plants to stay clear from:

Azalea/Rhododendron	Laburnum
Cotoneaster	Lilies
Geranium	<u>Oak</u>
Grave Vine	Oleander
Holly	Potato plant
<u>Hydrangea</u>	Rhubarb
lvy	Tomato Plant

- 2. Create a chill out spot. Make sure there is shade they can lay in and a cool surface to lay on. Examples:
 - a. Raised beds.
 - b. Cooling mats
 - c. Fresh drinking water
- 3. Water activities. This can be from a kiddie pool, sprinklers, or a splash pad. Many of us have multiple dogs in our homes, make sure that the water activities are in a spot where your dogs do

not need to engage with the water if they are afraid. We want to make sure our yards are a positive place for all dogs.



4. Outside toys, yes please! Have some fun outdoor games that are safe and durable for your pups available. We as owners cannot stay outside and play fetch all day with them. But we can't have them chew on sticks, rocks, or our houses. Make sure that the toys you do choose for your dog is sturdy for chewing, but they cannot swallow, and the toy cannot splinter or break. Examine all toys before your dog plays to make sure that they are still safe. One of my girls favorite outside toys is the KONG Medium Dog Toy Jumbler Ball. She can throw it herself or we can throw it for her. See picture below.



5. Pet playground. The possibilities are endless. You can add a safe place for them to dig and play scent games. Introduce them to kids' jungle gym to let them slide down and climb up. Training agility kits are great to get some training sessions in and practice a new skill.



Remember when building Fido's Wonderland, you don't need to relandscape your yard to make them have a grand time. Just add a few new additions for the family to enjoy and rotate them occasionally.


