OPEN CLASS AVAILABLE ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS AT 7 PM

- The class will cover obedience, working with dumb bells, and jumps.
- Dogs are preferred to have passed a minimum CGC test or CGCA and have worked beyond basic obedience or towards a CD title.
- Items needed for class: A proper fitting dumb bell for the dog, 6 ft lead and a, minimum 15 ft lead and proper training collar is required.

TRICK OF THE MONTH Hoop Jump

Difficulty: Easy Verbal Cue: Hoop

Preparation: Before teaching your dog to jump through the hoop, remove the beads inside to make it less scary for your dog.

Steps:

- 1. Position the hoop to allow your dog to walk through. Lure your dog through the hoop with a treat.
- 2. Once your dog is confident in walking through the hoop raise the hoop off the floor and lure them to go through. If your dog gets tangled in the hoop drop it to the floor and let them get out of it.
- 3. Raise the hoop in the air and give him a running start. Luring him through the hoop once the dog goes through the hoop toss the treat for the reward.
