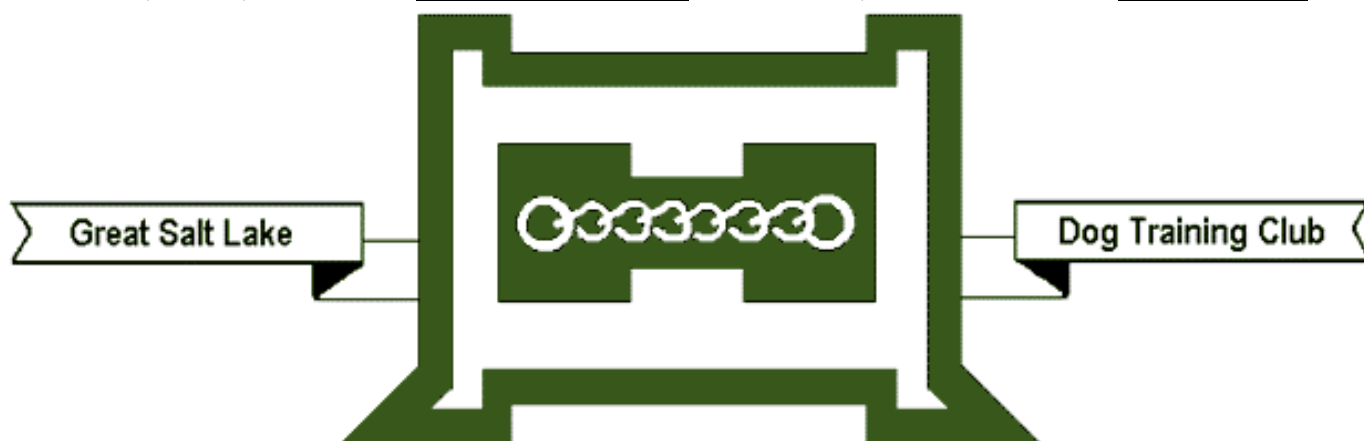

No 'Exhibition Only' or conditional entries will be permitted, and a signed entry form and payment must be received before the show closes to be considered valid. **Please contact Show Secretary for information about online entries.** There will be an additional service charge for electronic/online entries. No entry will be deemed complete until all information and payment has been confirmed.

PLEASE NOTE: Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing. An administrative fee of \$3.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

Dogs owned or co-owned by Club Officers, Show Chair, Members of the Event Committee, Show Trial Secretary, and Members of their households will be eligible for entry at this event.

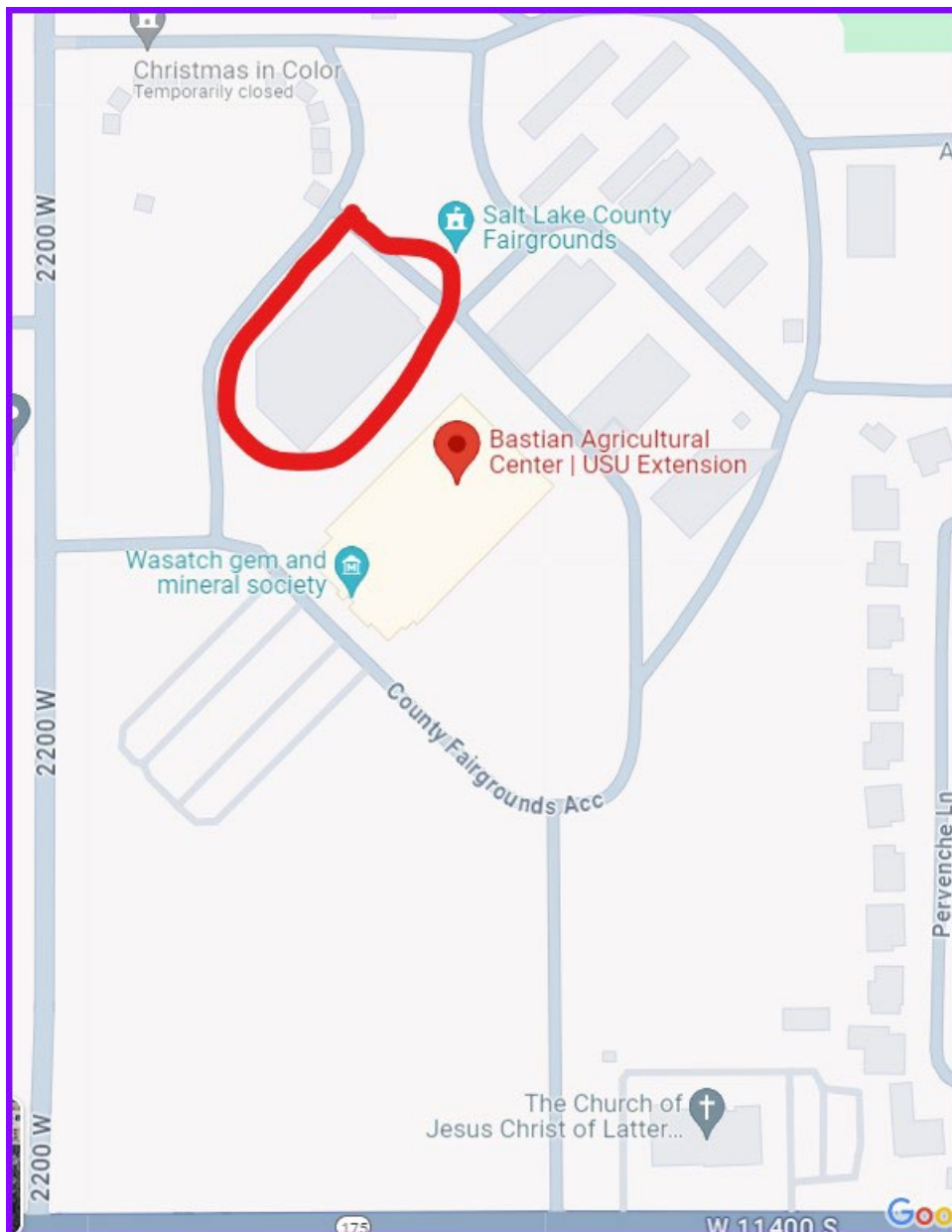

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am each trial day. Dogs must be removed DAILY from the show site immediately following completion of the last scheduled class. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted at the fairgrounds. Handlers—Please clean up after your dogs and your area as required.

Exhibitors must keep dogs under control and restrained at all times. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Utah State Law requires all dogs over four (4) months of age be current on rabies vaccination.

Exhibitors MUST be governed by any rules and regulations of the Show Site and/or local restriction. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except with being judged. Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Show Committee.

NO Double handling will be permitted at these trials, and attempts to do so from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Trial Committee.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the show.

Chapter 2, Section 26, Obedience Regulations— "There will be no intensive nor abusive training of dogs on the grounds or premises at a AKC licensed or member obedience trial or sanctioned match." This rule will be strictly enforced; violators will be subject to a Trial Committee hearing. Special training devices that are used to control and train dogs, including but not limited to, collars with prongs, electric collars used with transmitters, muzzles, and head collars may not be used on dogs at AKC Events, except as allowed in the AKC Rules, Regulations, and policies.

The judging procedure may be modified to accommodate special-needs handlers.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

The show-giving Club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without correct fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic means prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing. An administrative fee of \$3.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Entries will be acknowledged no later than after entries close with an entry acknowledgement. Judging Program will be emailed to Exhibitor's email address after show closes and schedule is determined. It is imperative you review the acknowledgement for accuracy and/or missing data. If you wish your Agent to receive an acknowledgement of your entry and/or judging schedule, please submit request with entry, show name and Agent's correct email address for this courtesy. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary by phone at (801)898-9759 or email at DogShowSec@gmail.com.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, and their property, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of any accident or misfortune due to entering dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at each Trial and will not be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Trials. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Trials Premium List.

OBEDIENCE ENTRY FEES include 50 cents AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC event service fee.

RALLY ENTRY FEES include \$3.50 AKC first entry recording fee and \$3.00 second entry recording fee.

These AKC fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These are not in addition to your entry fee; they are included in your entry fee where applicable and will be paid by the Show-Giving Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

No flash photography is allowed, except by Show Photographer as needed.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. In the event of a Returned check, a replacement check will not be acceptable and guaranteed funds will be required. Guaranteed funds are defined as Money Order, Cashier's Check, PayPal Transfer, or Cash. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, except as noted above.

Entry Fees will not be refunded after the closing date and time. Anyone wishing to pull entries must do so in writing prior to the closing date and time. There will be a small fee for this convenience.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. - A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is record in his/her name.
