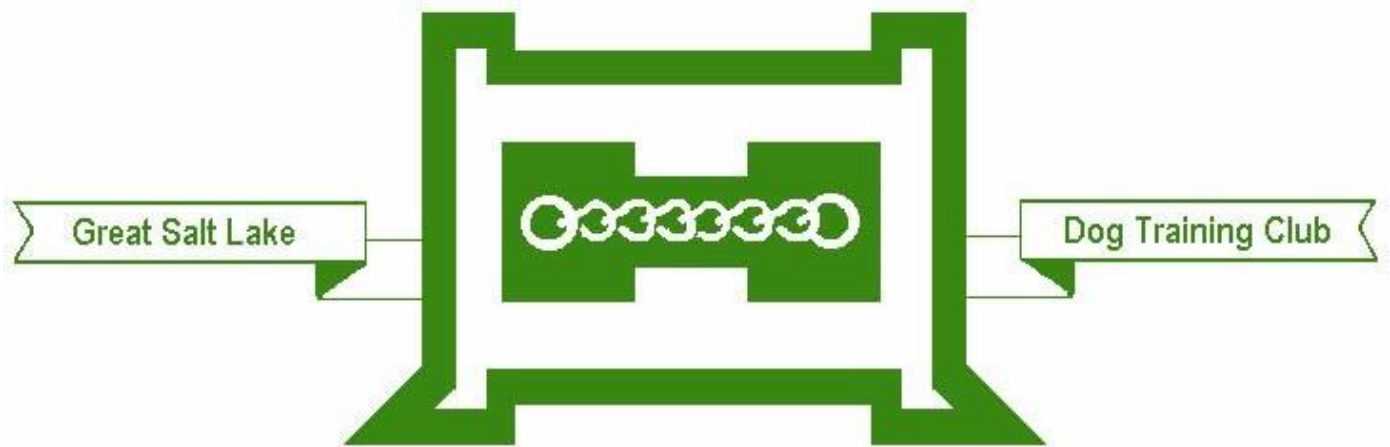

ENTRY LIMITS

TDU TEST IS LIMITED TO SIX (6) ENTRIES

ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry fee is \$75.00 for the Tracking Dog Urban Test. (This includes the .50 recording fee, and the \$4.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) Entries close at 5:00PM on Wednesday, October 7, 2026. Fees must accompany entries. Only ONE (1) entry per dog will be accepted. All checks and money orders for Tracking are to be made payable to Great Salt Lake Dog Training Club, in U.S. Funds, and mailed to Misty Porter, 195 S Jodi Lane, Grantsville, UT 84029.

Facilities are NOT available for facsimile and/or credit card entries. With the entry form for a dog that has not "passed" an AKC Tracking Test, there must be included an ORIGINAL CERTIFICATION statement, dated within two years, signed by either a person approved to judge tracking tests, or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last ten (10) years, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Test Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent entering the dog in a test in which the dog is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY REST SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

A MAXIMUM ENTRY OF Six (6) TDUs IS SET FOR THESE EVENTS. All entries will be accepted up to the closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A random drawing will be held at the National Guard Armory, 7602 So. Airport Rd., West Jordan, UT at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, October 7, 2026, to determine SIX (6) entries and numbered alternates' positions corresponding to the number in which they are drawn.

Dogs holding the Tracking Dog title shall not be barred from competition, but dogs not having a "TD" or "TDU" will be given preference for entry in respective test by the Tracking Secretary.

Bitches in season may participate under the conditions specified in Chapter 2, Section 8, of the Tracking Regulations. The Test Secretary and Judges must be notified of the bitch in season prior to drawing of tracks.

Please be sure to include email address so that we may notify you as quickly as possible the results of the drawing.

The test worker draw option, as allowed by the AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 17d, will be used in this TDU test for workers only as defined by the Great Salt Lake Dog Training Club Board of Directors and published on our website and in our newsletter.

Two tracks will be available at this TDU test for the workers from our previous TD test held during 2026. The club does have a list of the TD Tracklayers from 2026 and will place workers vouchers.

NOTICE – The alternates have the option of accepting or declining to continue as alternates. Alternates who accept, and who are present at the test will have the opportunity of competing in place of an absent entry in the order established previously. Alternates must notify the Test Secretary of the acceptance or refusal within ten (10) days following the closing date.

Failure to contact the Test Secretary within the time allowed shall constitute a decline. Alternates contacting the Test Secretary and exercising the right to decline within the time allowed shall have their entry fees returned. Alternates accepting and present at the test who are not given the opportunity to compete shall have their entry fee returned. No refund will be given for any reason other than those stated in this paragraph.

TDU tracking cover will be grass, asphalt, concrete, bark, etc. as used in a TDU test.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The GSLDTC will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers, spectators and their property, but neither the Club nor the individual property owners will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to dog, person or property on the TDU grounds.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close, with entry acknowledgment mailed or emailed to the address on entry. Should the Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Test Secretary by telephone (801) 953-2496.

ADDITIONAL TEST RULES

Littering and other abuses of property are not permitted.

Exhibitor Parking & Arrival Instructions Bluffdale City Park (BCP) – Draw Location

The draw will be held at **Bluffdale City Park**, at the back of the Test Secretary's truck.

Please follow these directions:

- Enter the park using the route marked with the **thick yellow line**.
- **Park ONLY** in the area marked with the **thin yellow line** (yellow circled parking area).
- **Do NOT drive or walk** in any area marked with a **red X**.
- Dogs may eliminate only in the areas marked with **light purple circles**.

- Restrooms will **NOT** be available until **after both tracks at Bluffdale City Park have been completed**. Please plan to stop at another restroom before arriving.



Traveling to Wardle Park

Use the provided map to travel from **Bluffdale City Park** to **Wardle Park**.

At Wardle Park:

- Follow the **yellow route** to enter the park.
- **Park ONLY** in the **yellow circled parking area**.
- Dogs may eliminate **ONLY** in the **green designated potty area**.
- **Do NOT park or walk** in any area marked with a **red X**.
- The **orange "P"** marks the pavilion we have reserved. Hospitality will be located there.
- **Restrooms will NOT be available until after the first track has been completed**. If needed, please use the restroom facilities at Bluffdale City Park before traveling to Wardle Park.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
