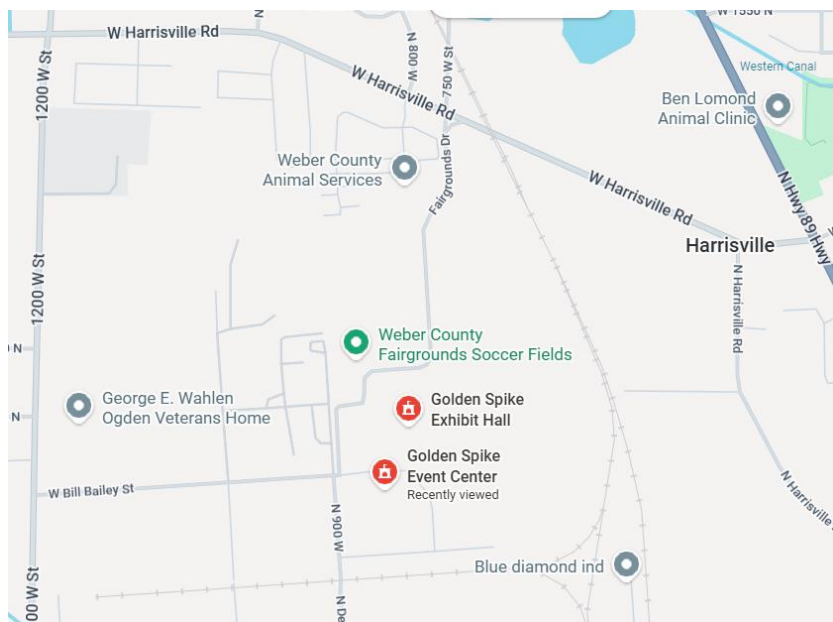

FUN RUNS ARE ONLY BEING OFFERED FRIDAY 10/23/26 between 1:00 PM- 3:00 PM. There will be no Fun Runs any other day of the event. We will offer a total of 35 Fun Runs.

A 30-minute lunch break for all volunteers will be taken each day. The lunch break hours will be posted, and no runs will be held during that break.

****Day- Of entries will ONLY be taken if the limit has not been reached****

To qualify for the volunteer time block you must commit to at least 2 hours of volunteering. This can be arranged by emailing the secretary. Volunteers that have dogs entered will have priority to run each day in the volunteer time block to allow them to be available to help others. Volunteer time block Friday 3-3:30 PM; Saturday 8-9 AM; Sunday 8-9 AM.

Test hours and entry cap for each day:

Please be aware: Time slots are different each day. Please verify your entries carefully before submitting your entry forms. Two events will be run concurrently each day.

Friday roll call: roll call begins at 2:30 PM for volunteers and 3:00 for everyone else and ends at 5:00 PM.

Friday 2:30 PM-6:00 PM, 2 events run concurrently, each event capped at 75 dogs. (Volunteer dogs will get preference to run in the time block 3:00-3:30PM)

Saturday Roll Call: Roll call begins at 7:30 for volunteers and 8:30 for everyone else and ends at 2:00 PM.

Saturday 7:30 AM-3:00, 2 events run concurrently, each event capped at 100 dogs. (Volunteer dogs will get preference to run in the time block 8:00- 9:00 AM)

ELIGIBLE DOGS

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not participate

Great Salt Lake Dog Training Club Fast CAT conditions of entry

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK
- In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be **lame, unfit to participate** or a **female in season** shall not be allowed to compete and entry fees shall be refunded in full.
- Dogs that are physically challenged due to loss of limbs are eligible to enter and should be given the same consideration by the inspection committee as four-legged dogs. A dog that exhibits a state of well-being at the time of inspection shows no signs of physical discomfort, and in the opinion of the inspection committee appears to physically have the potential to safely complete the course, is to be considered fit to participate. For safety purposes, any dog requiring an assistance apparatus, such as a wheeled cart will not be allowed to participate.
- **COMMUNICABLE DISEASES.** No dog with a communicable disease shall be on the event grounds or premises. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to ensure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Collars/muzzles:** Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. The GSLDTC strongly suggests **tags hanging from the collar be secured (e.g. taped to the collar, or whatever method the owner prefers)** to ensure the dog's safety. Dogs may be muzzled at the owner's discretion. If a muzzle is used, they must not have sharp, hard edges and must be of a basket type that allows the dog to open its mouth to pant and breath freely.
- Dogs must be leashed or crated at all times except when running - **strictly enforced.**
- No Flexi-leads/retractable leads are allowed on the test grounds.
- Any dog that displays aggressive behavior during test or trials hours may be disqualified by the event committee.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC, GSLDTC, any dog(s), or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site, and appropriate disciplinary action will be filed with the American Kennel Club (AKC) – please conduct yourselves accordingly.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

Photographer – We plan to have a photographer on site. Their information will be available at the Check in desk. We cannot guarantee photos of every dog, though every effort will be made to capture as many dogs as possible.

General Information:

- GSLDTC recommends that your hounds be in good physical condition before attempting the course.
- Bring water and shade for you and your dogs.
- Pick up after your dog and yourself.
- Children must always be under control of their parents or guardians.

- A \$25 fee will be assessed for any returned checks
- We will have an earlier roll call and inspection for hounds of the test committee, workers and lure operators
- No meals are provided for exhibitors. Please pack your own snacks, drinks, meals.
- Electronic timing system will be used. Manual stopwatches will be secondary.
